Step 1

Set up your StudentAid.gov account by creating your FSA ID

- Go to StudentAid.gov.
- Click on "Create Account."

Step 2

Gather the information and documents you will need

- Student and parent Social Security numbers
- Student and parent 2024 federal income tax returns and W-2's or income earned from work
- Student and parent records of untaxed income
- Student and parent records of cash, savings and checking accounts, investments, and assets
- List of schools, colleges, or universities the student is interested in attending

Tips

- Both the student and at least one parent will need a StudentAid.gov account.
- The student and parent cannot share an FSA ID
- The student and parent each should use a personal email address to create the account (not a school or work email address)
- Check with the institution on priority deadlines.
